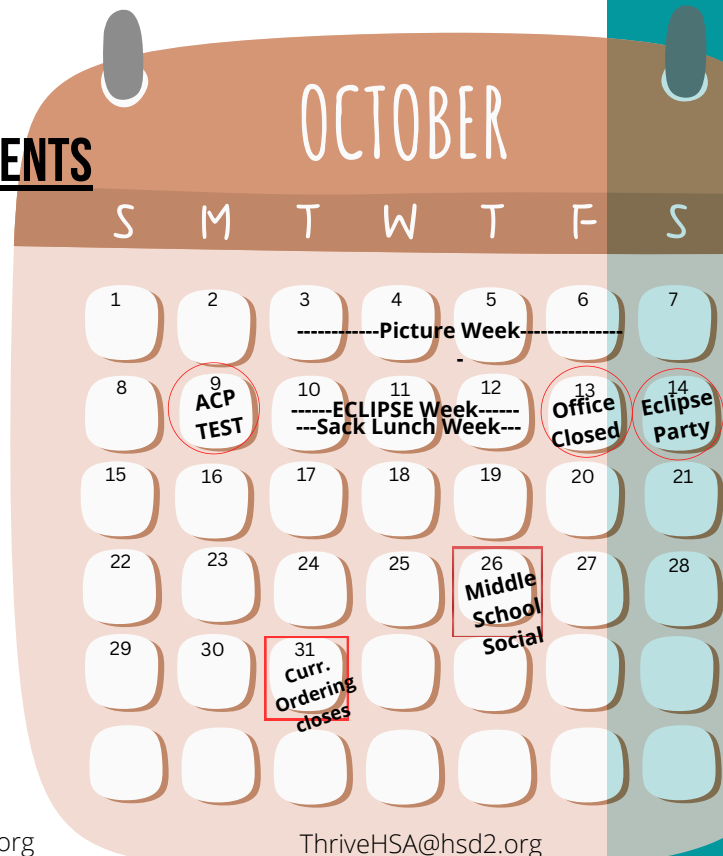

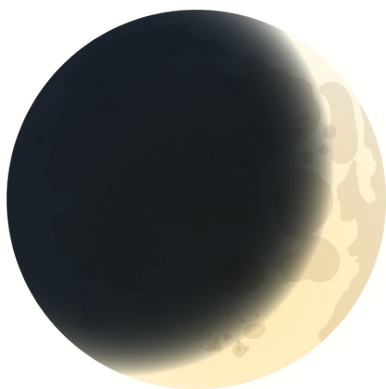
- Activities and sponsors for the event so far include:
